

DIRECTIONS TO THE STEINBACH MENNONITE HERITAGE MUSEUM
FROM WINNIPEG

1. Find your way to the Perimeter Highway #100 going east
2. Go east on Perimeter Highway #100 until you reach the ramp that says *“Trans-Canada Highway #1 Kenora East”*
3. Enter that ramp and merge onto the Trans-Canada Highway #1 going east
4. From that point go approximately 25 kilometers to Provincial Trunk Highway (PTH) #12... there are lots of signs showing that the Steinbach turn is at PTH #12
5. Go onto the ramp to go south to Steinbach on PTH #12
6. Drive south for about 18 kilometers... you will see that at that point you are entering Steinbach
7. You will see a Manitoba Star Attraction sign on the median for the Mennonite Heritage Museum
8. The museum is on the left side of Highway #12. There is a sign that will direct you to make a left U-turn on Clear Springs Road.
9. Make the U-turn and go back up PTH #12 north just a very short distance and the museum entrance is on the right-hand side. You can't miss it.
